What is the Theoretical Framework?

It is part of an investigation that provides support to the topic to be developed.

Begins with a review of articles, books, and other documents that are related to the research topic. It supports the research documentation.

The literature review includes identifying, obtaining and consulting the literature and other written materials useful for the purposes of the study, where you should extract and compile relevant and necessary information relevant to the research.

Must be selective and not an identical copy.

Must be well ordered and organized.






Company/Enterprise Framework?

Explain where the research is done: what the organization is dedicated to, what their functions are?, what products?, what are the Mission and Vision? and what is its organizational structure? Everything about the project.

You can use literal copies with their corresponding citations, according to the APA 6th or 7th Edition standard.

Remember that it must not be a collection of citations, therefore we recommend creating tables, maps, or summaries of the research material where you build upon the quotations with comments of your own...



Here is where you include definitions of all project management concepts related to your FGP topic





Other applicable theories/concepts related to the project topic and context

Depending on your FGP topic, you should include other definitions and related matters. For example:

- If your FGP is about a PMO, you can include types, features, benefits, etc.
- If your FGP is about a methodology you can include information on types of methodologies, benefits, etc.

It is recommended to include definitions, graphs, charts, etc.

Everything must be identified with a proper title (remember that rules are different for titles of figures and tables).
